Kimberly-Clark acquired the majority shares in S-K Corporation in July 2000 and 100-percent interest in Taiwan Scott Paper Company in December 2000.

Ken Marshall, Chairman & Group Managing Director of Kimberly-Clark Taiwan said, "Kimberly-Clark Corporation has increased its investment significantly in Taiwan because we have great confidence in the economic future of the island and in the long term strength of its consumer and commercial products market. In the coming years we will continue to innovate, improve and launch new products and hopefully play a part in helping Taiwan consumers live happier, healthier lives."

The Personal Care sector, which markets disposable baby diapers and feminine napkins under the Huggies and Kotex brands, will be led by President and Managing Director Frank Lin, who previously served as Managing Director of S-K Corporation.
